- c) Be solely responsible for the growing, harvesting and timely delivery all the harvested grain from my farm to KBL receiving point.
- d) Use acceptable procedures for growing the crop and I do understand that the role of KBL Agribusiness service is advisory to protect KBL interests and therefore does not at all confer any rights to me or obligations on the part of EAML and its officials.
- e) Not hold KBL to be responsible for any loss in profits or expenses incurred in the event that I obtain low yields or there is a crop failure for whatever reason.
- f) Abide by the terms hereof and the agreement signed with KBL and abide by KBL's Code of Business Conduct (The Diageo Code of Business Conduct) and "Partnering with Suppliers" Standards which both available on www.eabl.com and www.eabl.com and www.eabl.com and www.eabl.com and www.eabl.com and www.diageo.com . I have received and commit to comply with these codes as amended from time to time.
- g) Supply only locally grown crop in Kenya and shall NOT purchase grains from the market, or grain meant for food, Government aid, and other suppliers and or grain meant for relief.

17.1 ADDITIONAL COMMITMENT – APPLICABLE FOR SORGHUM GROWERS

As a potential sorghum/millet grower and supplier for Kenya Breweries Ltd, I declare that I am aware of the below sorghum supply guidelines: -

- a) I will only supply sorghum /or millet that is locally grown in Kenya (for individuals) and if given the status of an aggregator, shall ONLY purchase sorghum grown and traceable to have been grown in Kenya,
- b) Not to buy and supply any sorghum meant for food needs or food relief.
- I do understand it is prohibited to buy, mix or deliver any imported sorghum or millet as local raw material to KBL
- d) It is my obligation to pay cess fees to the county where the crop was grown and submit evidence of the same with each delivery, I make to KBL.
- e) That all my deliveries shall be made using the standard KBL documents and it is my responsibility to fill the required details accurately.
- f) All deliveries I make will be made either in bulk.
- g) I am not engaged in the import of sorghum grain to Kenya
- h) Any breach to the local raw materials supply guidelines will lead to cancellation of my contract.

17.3 COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABILITY GOALS AND CARE FOR ENVIROMENT
